The theme for this café is specifically focusing on Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCP). Joanne Thompson from SENDIASS is going to be running an initial presentation about EHCPs to allow parents to develop their understanding of what they are and when they are necessary for children. Parents will have the chance to ask questions and discuss queries with Joanne.

In addition, we will also be welcoming back colleagues from The Schools and Community Team. They will be available after the EHCP session to chat with parents and carers about any concerns, questions and simply be a listening ear. The team can offer specialist support and advice across a range of SEND areas and will provide an array of signposting tools.
